**RESOLUTION NO. 2007-254**

**WHEREAS**, the quality of one's life can be measured by its service to others; and

**WHEREAS**, Airman First Class Felicia Hunt while on a boating adventure on a Sunday afternoon, was suddenly presented with a situation to not only give assistance, but to help save the lives of two people; and

**WHEREAS**, Airman First Class Felicia Hunt was unaware of two boys being pulled from the Weeki Wachee River, found floating face down in the water, neither were breathing; and

**WHEREAS**, Airman First Class Felicia Hunt's boat had passed the crowd of people standing on the beach and she heard an outcry of "OH GOD, WHY!"; and

**WHEREAS**, Airman First Class Felicia Hunt made a quick decision to dive off her boat and swim to the beach to offer assistance without hesitation; and

**WHEREAS**, Airman First Class Felicia Hunt was the party who reacted immediately, moved through the crowd and once announcing she had been trained in CPR in the Air Force, started administering lifesaving skills to the first patient pulled from the water and continued compressions until the patient was stabilized. Airman Hunt then directed her assistance to the second patient until paramedics were on the scene and took over. Airman Hunt escorted the patients to the Rescue Unit.

**WHEREAS**, Airman First Class Felicia Hunt demonstrated the highest standards of professional conduct in her care giving of these two lives.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HERNANDO COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** The lifesaving importance of knowing and demonstrating CPR is hereby reaffirmed, and the resulting savings of life through this training is exulted.

**SECTION 2.** The heroic performance by Airman First Class Felicia Hunt in using her life saving skills while off-duty, is here by proclaimed as being of the highest level of service to our citizens.

**SECTION 3.** The Board of County Commissioners wishes to commend Airman First Class Felicia Hunt for her act of heroism and for putting into action her skills received through her Air Force training.






